Family Sunday School Commitment

Central United Methodist Church offers age appropriate, Biblically sound Sunday school to all ages. Devoted volunteer leaders prepare each week to bring lively and relevant lessons to your children.

In order for students to grow spiritually and socially in class, consistent attendance is of the utmost importance. I ask that you prayerfully consider the following guidelines before you sign your child(ren) up for Sunday school. Each family should:

- **Be responsible for materials and supplies** (\$1.00 per week, or \$15 per trimester, or \$45 for the year) if able. Creating the habit of giving can never be learned too young, and this is a great way to start.
- **Attend class *weekly*.**
 - Preschool lessons begin at 9:45 in room 104, ending at 10:50.
 - K-1st grade will begin promptly at 9:45 in room 306 to worship together, and then move at 10AM to room 103. Children can be picked up in room 103 at 10:50.
 - 2-3rd grades will begin promptly at 9:45 in room 306 to worship together, and then move at 10AM to room 309. Children can be picked up in room 309 at 10:50.
 - 4-5th grades will begin promptly at 9:45 in room 306 to worship together, and then move at 10AM to room 308. Children can be picked up in room 308 at 10:50.
 - 6-8th grades will begin promptly at 9:45 in room B of Fellowship Hall and will be dismissed at 10:50.
 - 9-12th grades will begin promptly at 9:45 in the Sr. High room and will be dismissed at 10:50.
- Should plan on **servicing in children's or youth ministry 2-3 times per year**. Parents can accomplish this by in many ways and a complete list and sign up can be found at the end of your family registration form. One of the most important ways to serve is by co-leading activities while our dedicated teachers are in training three times a year.
- Help, as the Lord leads, with **special offerings** that are collected occasionally such as the Heifer Read to Feed project and the Children's Library book expansion.
- Plan on a set family discussion time each week to talk about the week's lesson. The ride home from church, or during lunch following church is a great time while thoughts are still fresh in everyone's minds. Families will be emailed the topic of Sunday's lesson the Friday prior.

Adult Sunday school classes foster spiritual and personal growth and help parents remain connected to the Church. Attending class on a regular basis sets a beautiful example of the importance of education as well as deepening your own faith.

Our expectation is that parents involve themselves in a Sunday school class also.
