Here are projects where we will be serving:

- ♥ **Our Neighbors' Garden:** preparing the ground and planting this year's crop. Produce will eventually be distributed to food pantries in the region. Location: Garfield Road & Three Mile (next to former site of Christ UM Church). Tools provided. Contact person: John Ellinger (cell) 231-631-9237.

- ♥ **Fulton Park** to spread wood chips on trails. Location: You can access the park from the TART Trail or from Carter Road off of M-22. The work will be unloading and spreading chips on trail. - ♥ **Beach clean-up around Clinch Park and Sunset Park.** Bring work gloves & a garbage bag. Contact person: Dave Thomas (cell) 231-709-1330.

- ♥ **Northport Indian Mission Campgrounds:** raking, blowing leaves, tree-trimming, replacing screens. Location: Northport. **SPECIAL NOTE: This project requires departing earlier in order to arrive Northport by 9am.** Plan on staying for lunch provided by Native American community. (bring rake).
