Prayer Station

*Today we're talking about love and ethics. Being ethical means we hold our behavior to high moral standards, even when no one is watching. It means that an ethical person has a higher standard than just avoiding a certain behavior or practice because it is illegal. What matters is that it might be the wrong thing to do morally, or may de-value another person. Being ethical is a way of loving our neighbor as ourselves. Look again at the list of behaviors in the passage from Romans, listed above. What is an ethical behavior you see that the world especially needs from you / us right now? What behavior (on the list or not) do you think it important to hold to as a moral & spiritual person? **Turn to your neighbor and share your thoughts.***
