

Guest Protocols for Indoor Worship

Church in the Park Protocols (Page 2)

Worship Times • 9 am - Well Service • 11 am - Traditional Service

Masks will be worn by all in attendance, for the welfare of all those in attendance who have not yet been vaccinated due to age or by choice.

Pre-Registration - Attendance tracking required for each service, and your registration will help streamline the health screening at check-in.

- Anyone who arrives without registering will be directed to a separate check-in process, which includes a paper form of a health screening questionnaire.
- Participation is dictated by the most current State Executive Order Adjustments to Worship Programming - Services will be conducted by Pastoral Staff, using social distancing with:
 - a limited physical-distancing seating plan
 - 45-minute worship program

For the safety of all, the following practices will not be occurring until further notice:

- Church bus transportation
- Welcome Desk in the Gathering Place
- Handshaking
- Printed bulletins. Announcements and service order will be projected on the monitors
- Fellowship/hospitality time following services

Childcare and Children's Ministry programs will not be offered during worship. However, children are welcome to attend services with their families. Take home children's worship bags are available at the Gathering Space table. Children's time, during the 11 am service, are offered while children stay in their pews. How-to Register: A link to a simple registration form is emailed Friday morning in the CUMC newsletter. Registration is closed at midnight on Saturday to allow time to prepare for Sunday morning screening. Phone registrations will be taken between 9 am and 1 pm on Friday in the church office.

Requirements for entry:

- Clear the CUMC health screening process.
- Wear a face mask at all times. Disposable masks are available.
- Use hand sanitizer upon entry.
- Physical distance from anyone not of your household.

Checking-In on Sunday occurs in the Gathering Space outside the Sanctuary.

Seating Procedures:

1. All guests are asked to self-monitor their adherence to COVID guidelines while in the building, i.e. remain 6 feet from non-household members, no congregating, etc.

2. Seating availability will remain in every other pew. A spacing noodle will be available in each pew for guests to check their distance from others.
3. Everyone will be allowed to seat themselves.
4. Ushers will help, if necessary.
5. Family members, or friends, of different households who sit together do so at their own risk.

Exiting:

Each family group will be able to exit on their own. Guests exit directly out of the building, without congregating to socialize. They use the east side of the stairway to exit. All doors are available to exit.

Guest Protocols for Church in the Park

June 13 – June 27

Registration is *necessary* through June 27th. Attendance tracking is required for each service.

MASKS are to be worn unless you are vaccinated.

Pre-Registration online will allow you to bypass the need to register during the service using your phone and a QR code.

Registering Onsite will be done using your phone and a QR code, or signing-in at a check-in station. Instructions will be given during announcements.

Services will be conducted by Pastoral Staff, using social distancing with:

- a limited physical-distancing seating plan
- 45-minute worship program

Bulletins will be available:

- On your smart device, accessing the bulletin using a QR code. Instructions given on signage and during announcements.
- Paper, passed out by greeters.

Seating will be self-monitored using 6 feet between household pods.

- Bring your own chair and or blanket.
